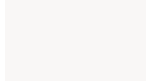




## FT225\_MX\_001 OBSIDIENNE

Following a printed fabric of the same name, Maison Pierre Frey reproduces OBSIDIENNE, the abstract work of the American artist Heather Chontos, on a quality of handmade carpet. The subtle balance between the strength of the gesture and the graphic expression of the motif is reflected in a play of cut silk velvet pile on a linen ground, artisanaly woven.
