For Yves Klein, art is a quest for reality and the work is the trace of the artist's communication with the world. He also maintains that poetic sensitivity is capable of revealing concrete realities.

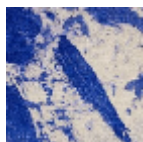
