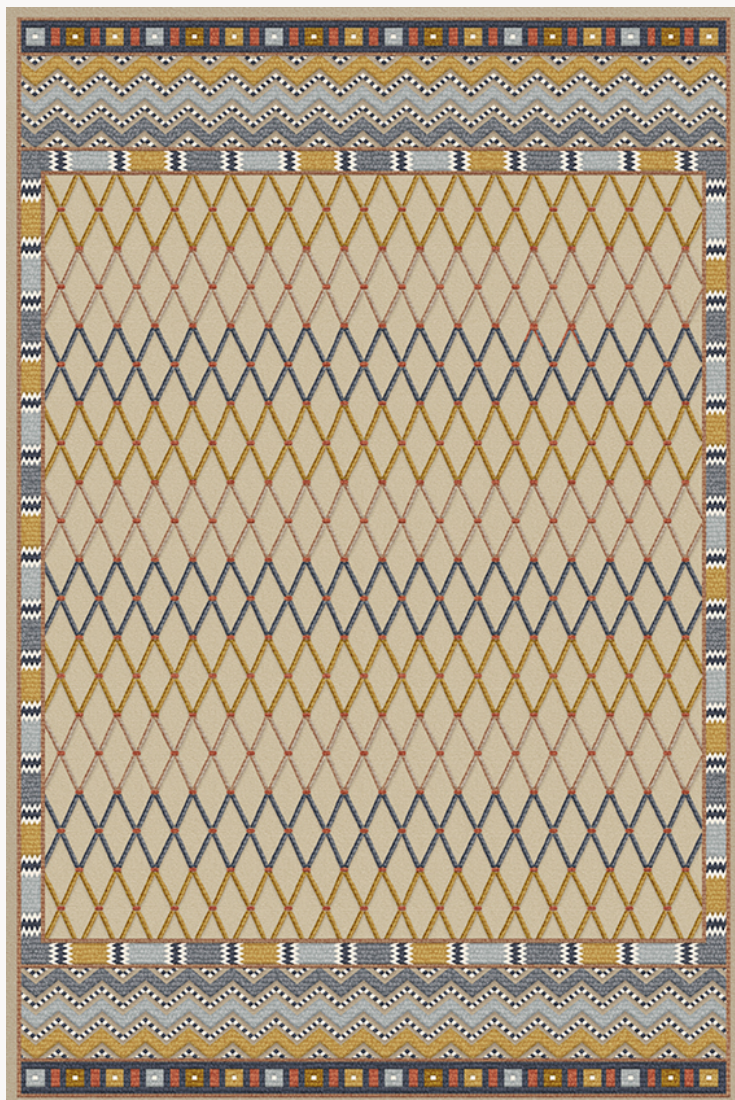


FT319002 ABYDOS
