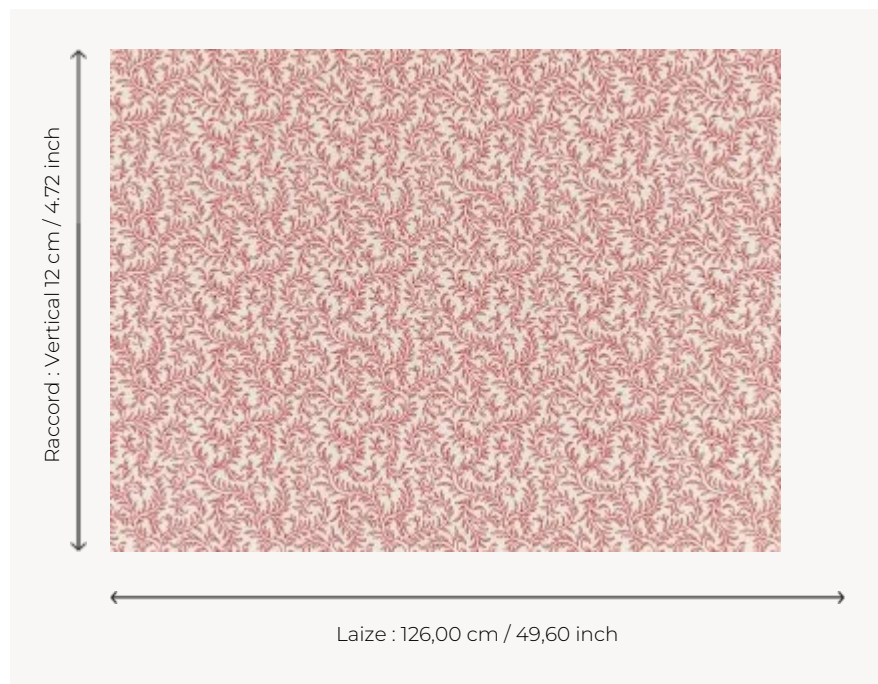


## B1886001 VERMICULE POSITIF
