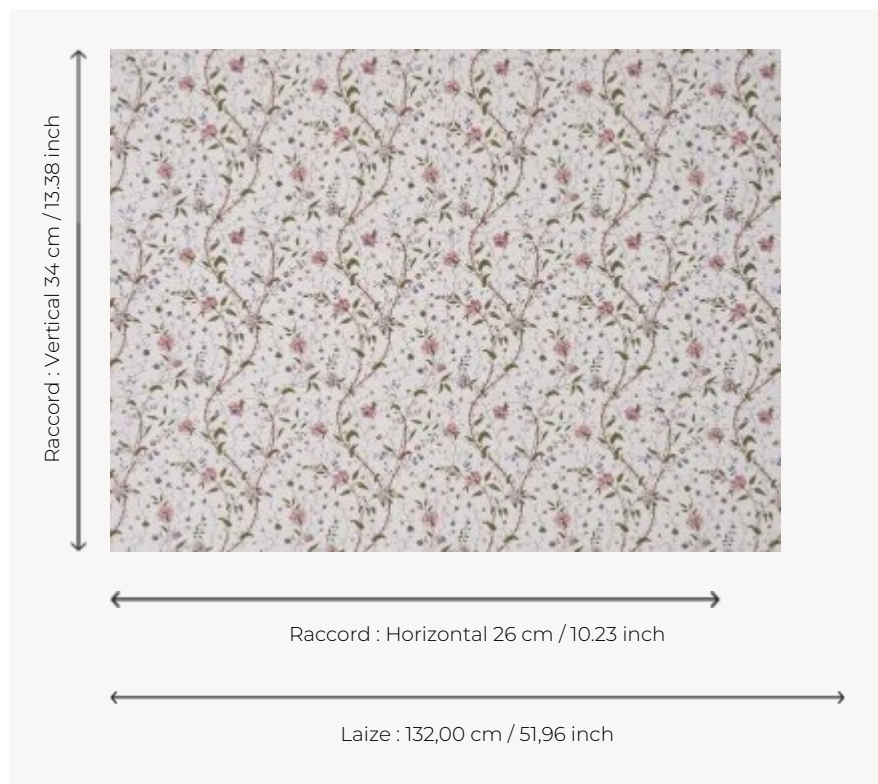


## B7652001 MADAME DE POLIGNAC
