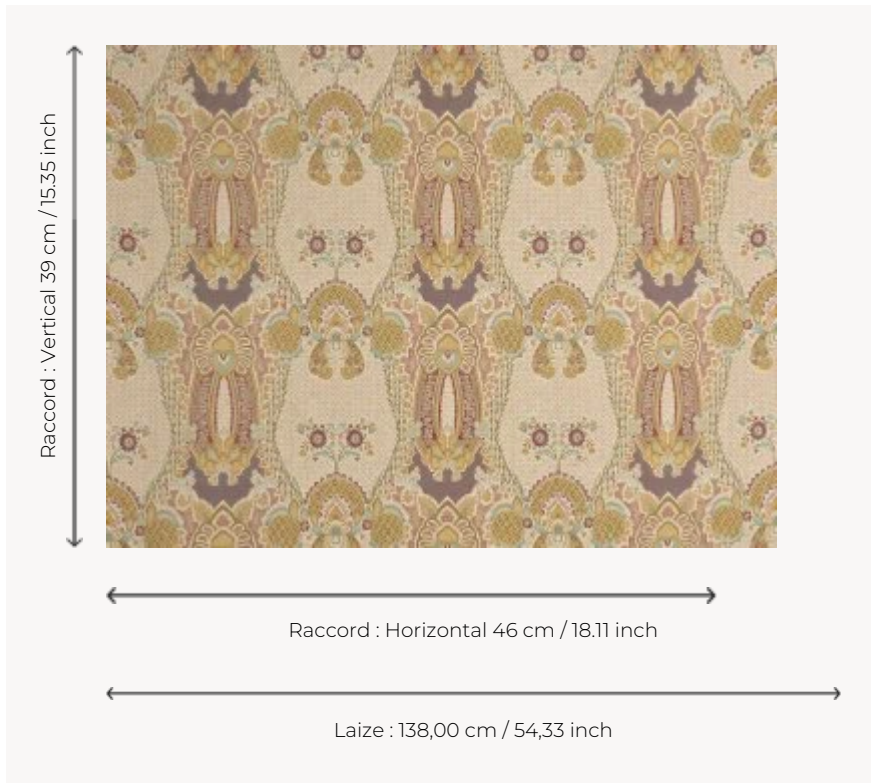



## B7661001 LA VALETTE SOIERIE

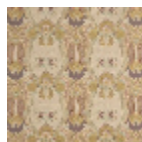
