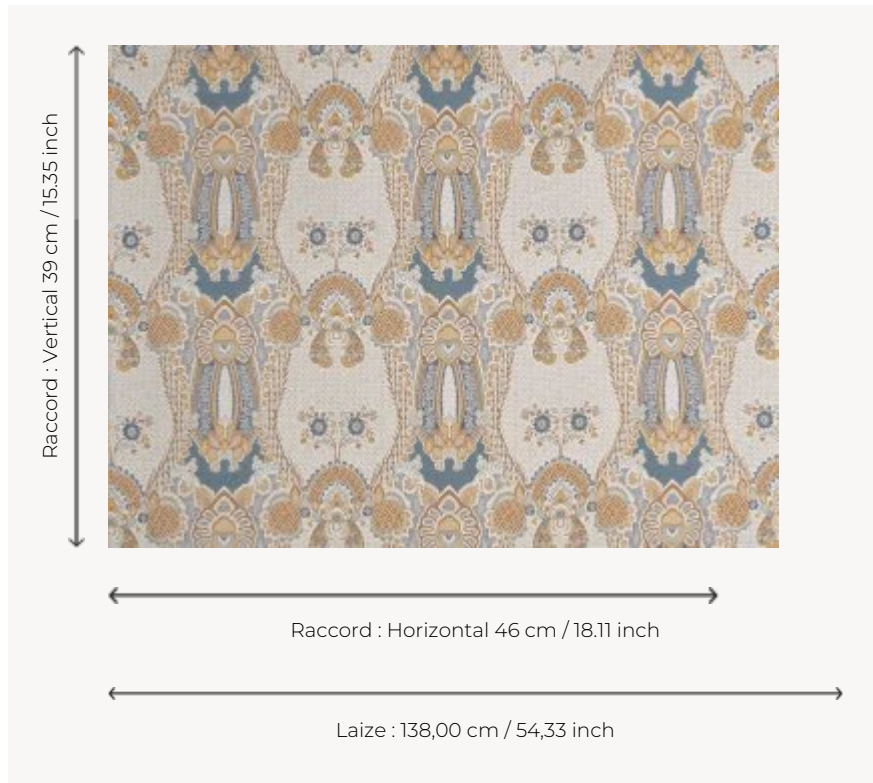


B7661002 LA VALETTE SOIERIE
