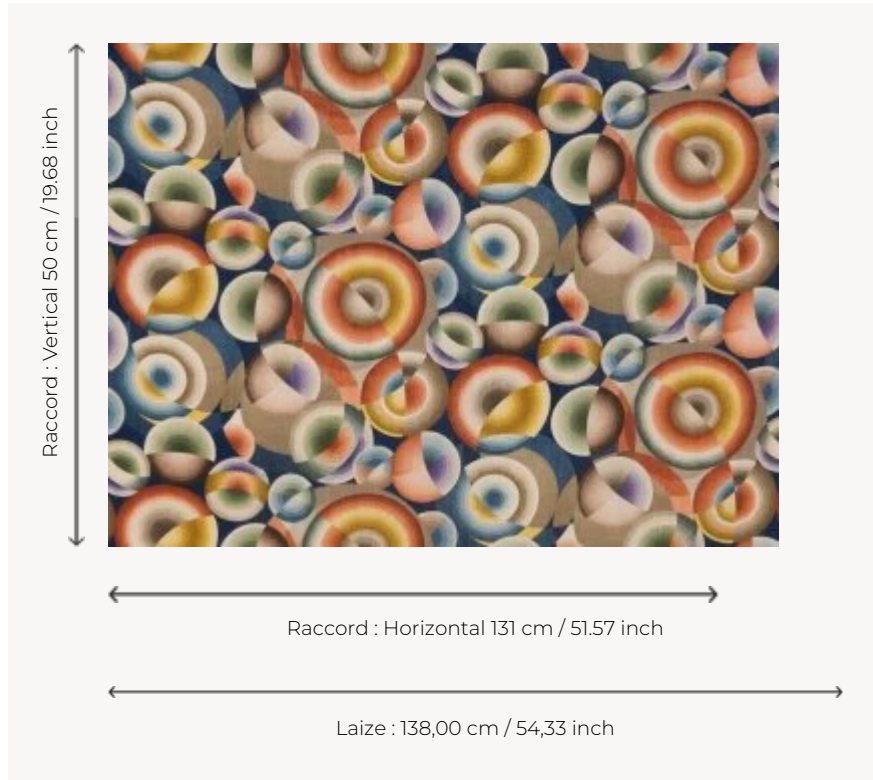


## F2938001 MIL NEUF CENT VINGT

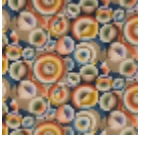
