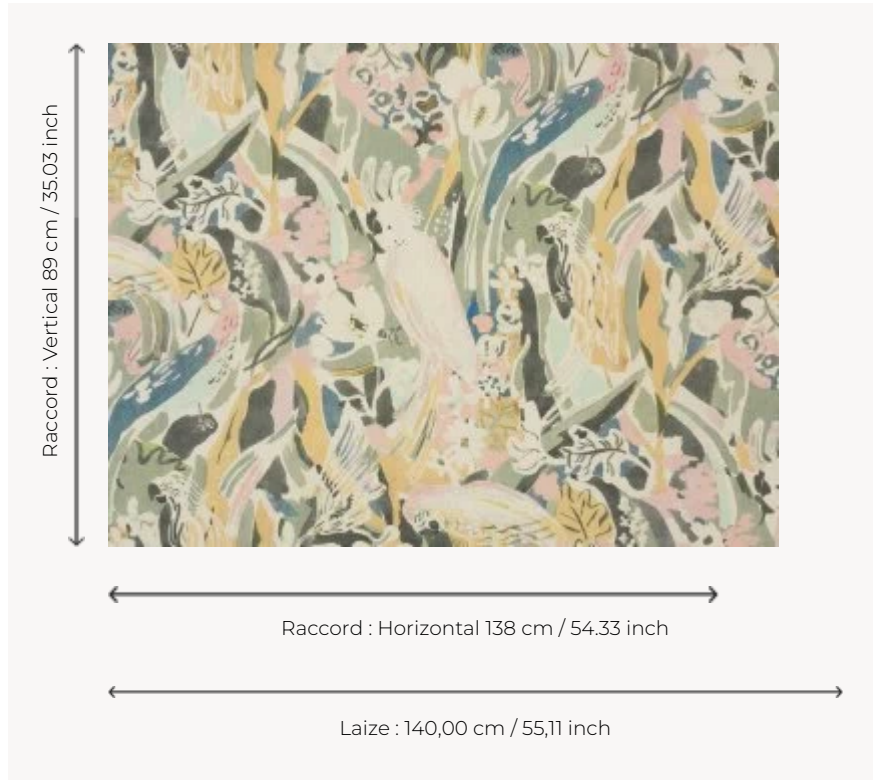


## F3252001 LE CHANT DE TIDORE

This is a re-edition of a creation designed for Pierre Frey by Jean-Denis Malclès in the forties. This colorful, swirling composition expresses joy and happiness in a tropical setting.
