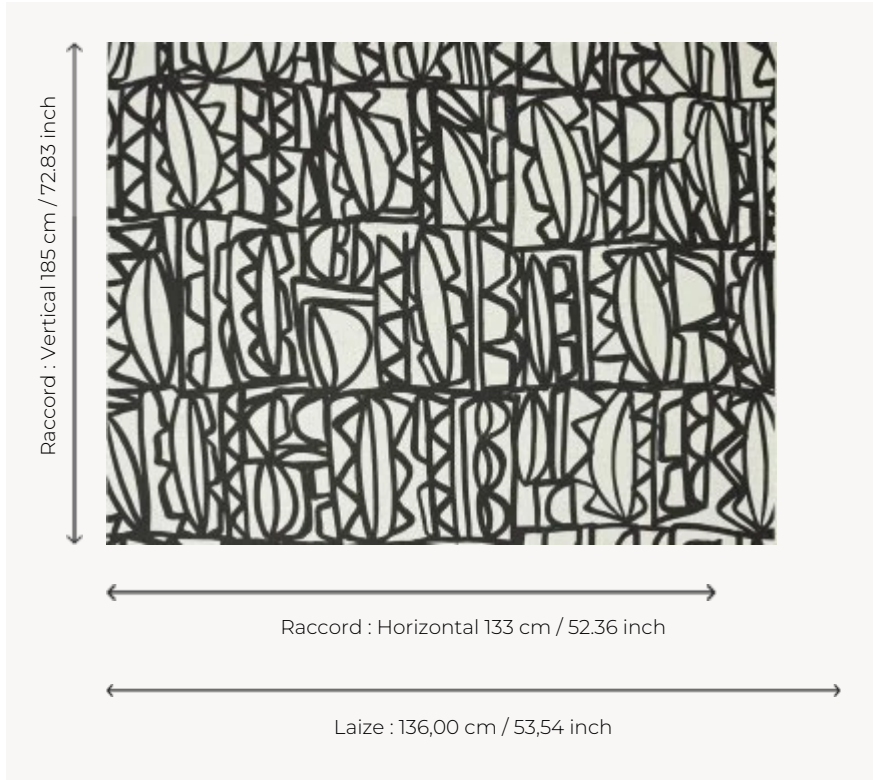


## F3382001 SYMBOLES
