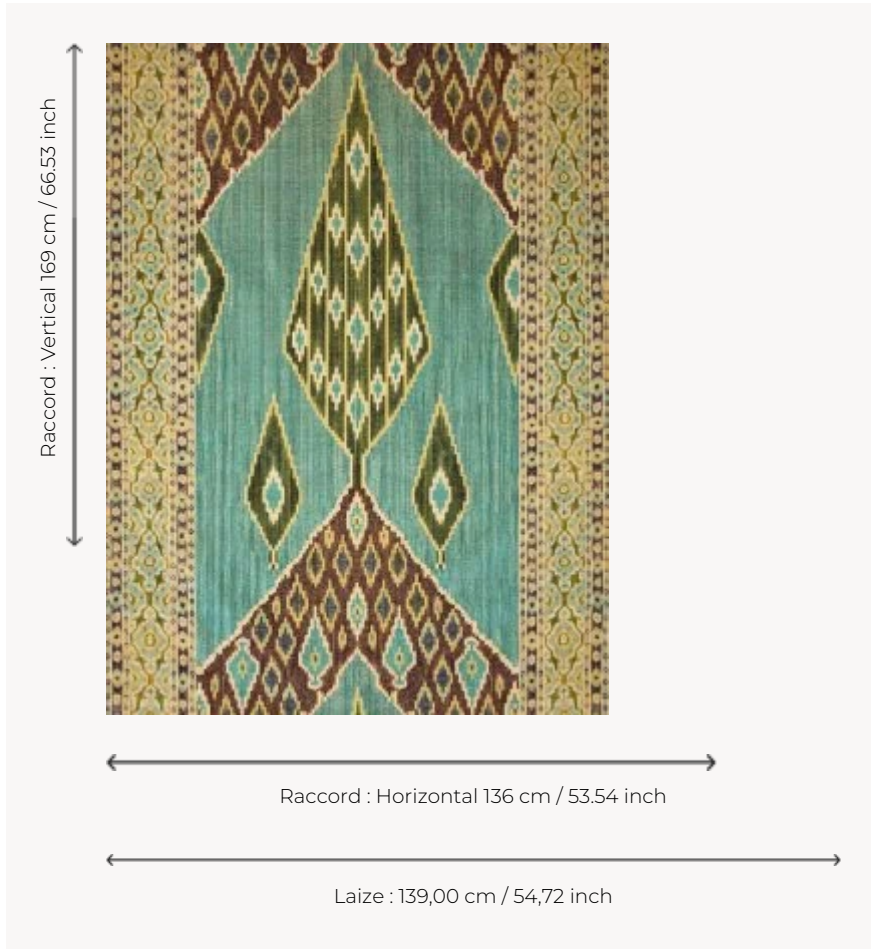


## F3459002 SINOP

To best reflect the beauty of this archive, the marks of time on the precious fibers have been replicated, as well as the typical borders of the drawing. As a wall hanging, upholstery or curtains, this design can match with or without the borders, presenting grandiose herringbones.

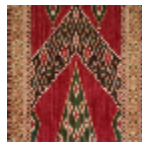
