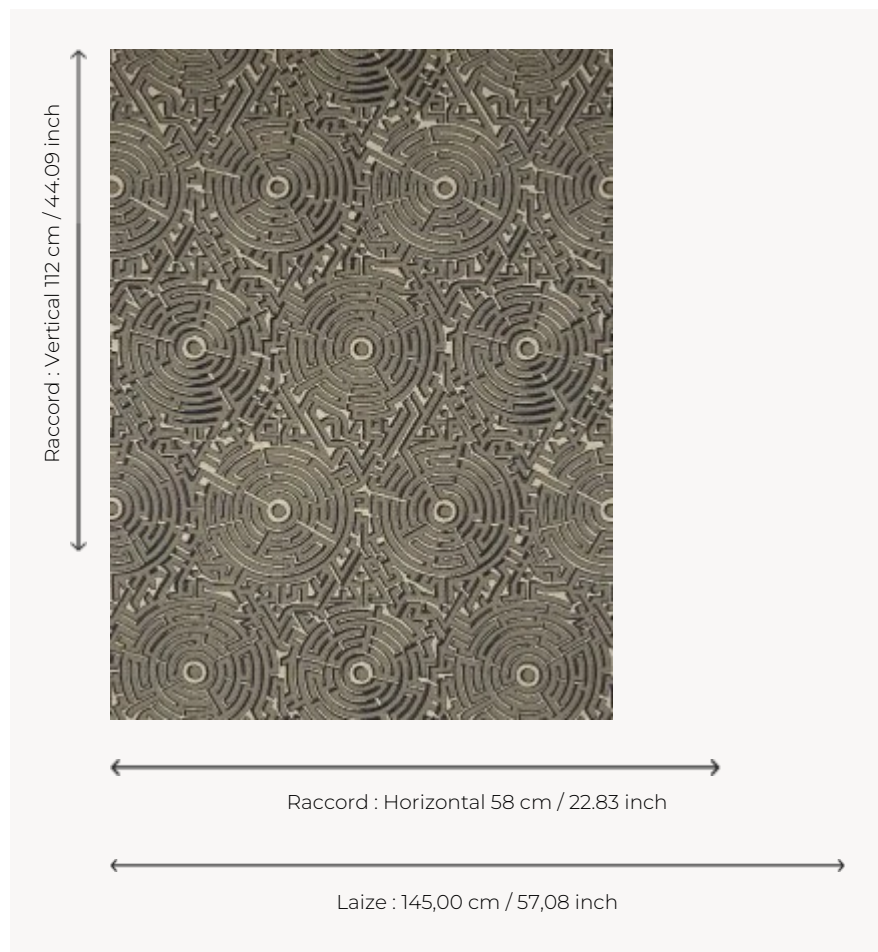



## F3549002 HEDGEROW

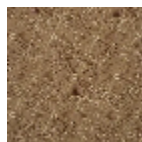
