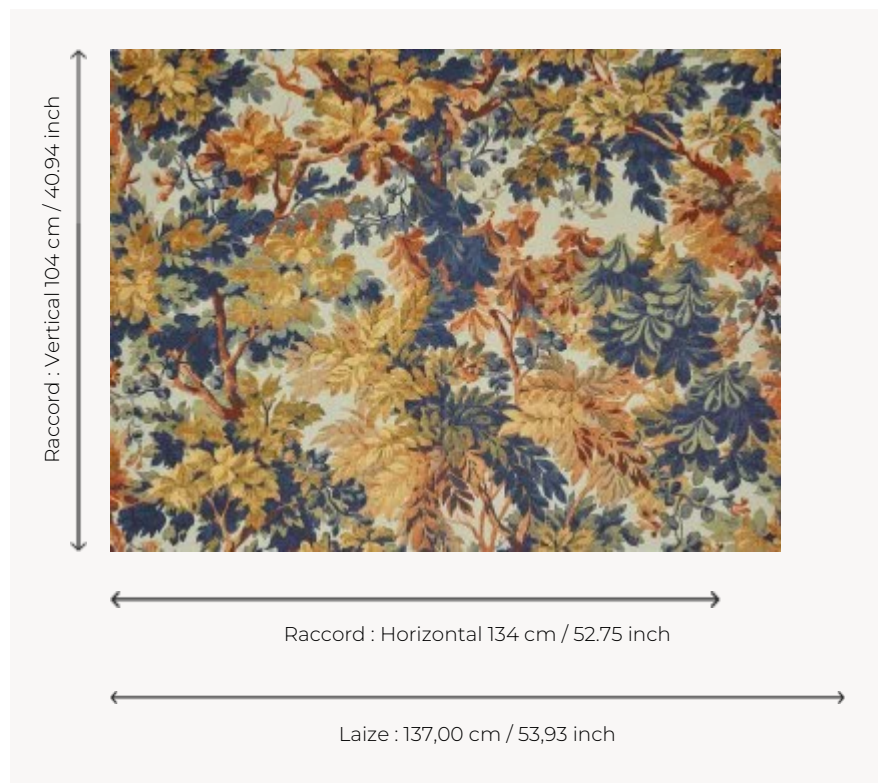


## F3605003 FONTAINEBLEAU

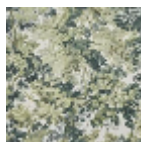

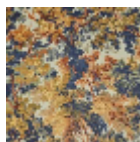
