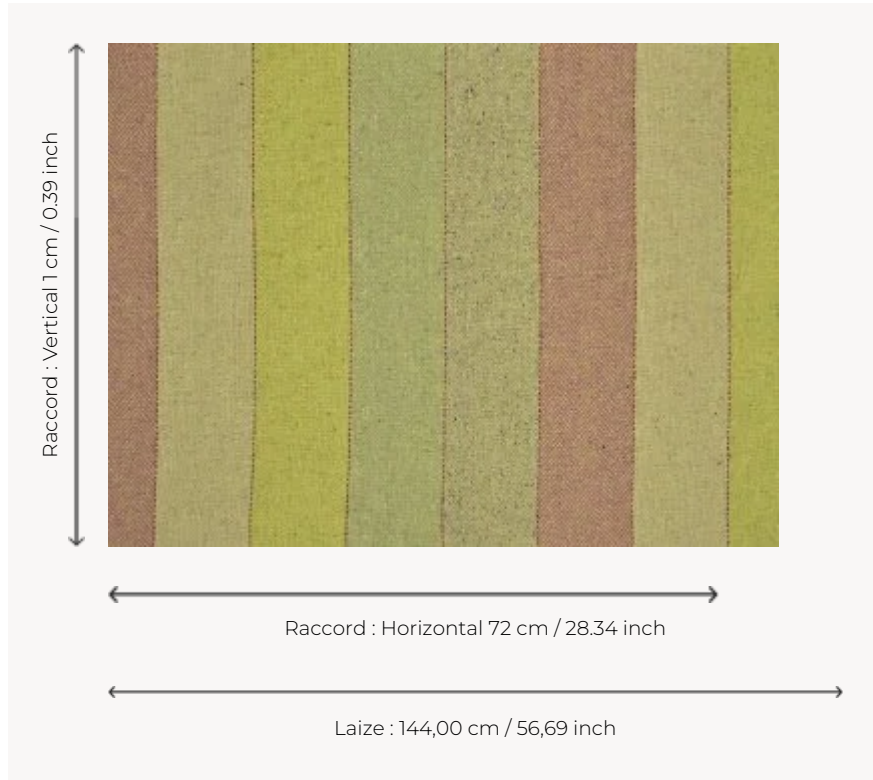


## F3643002 TESS

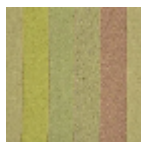
