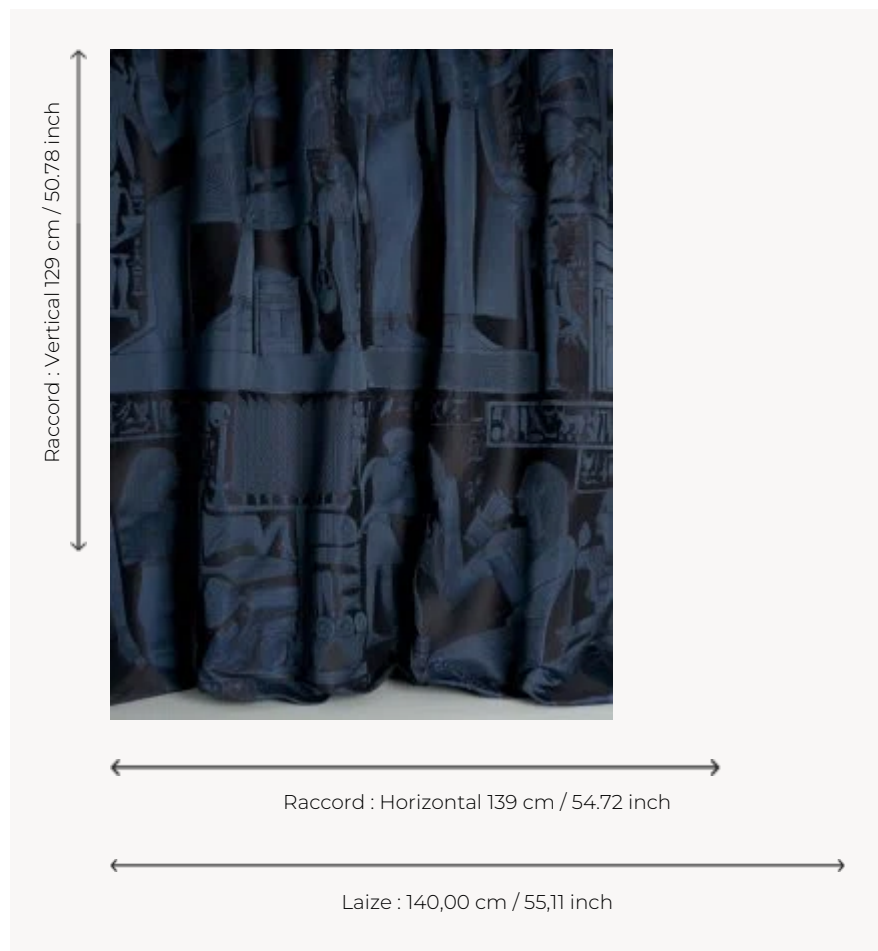


## F3652003 ABKAOU
