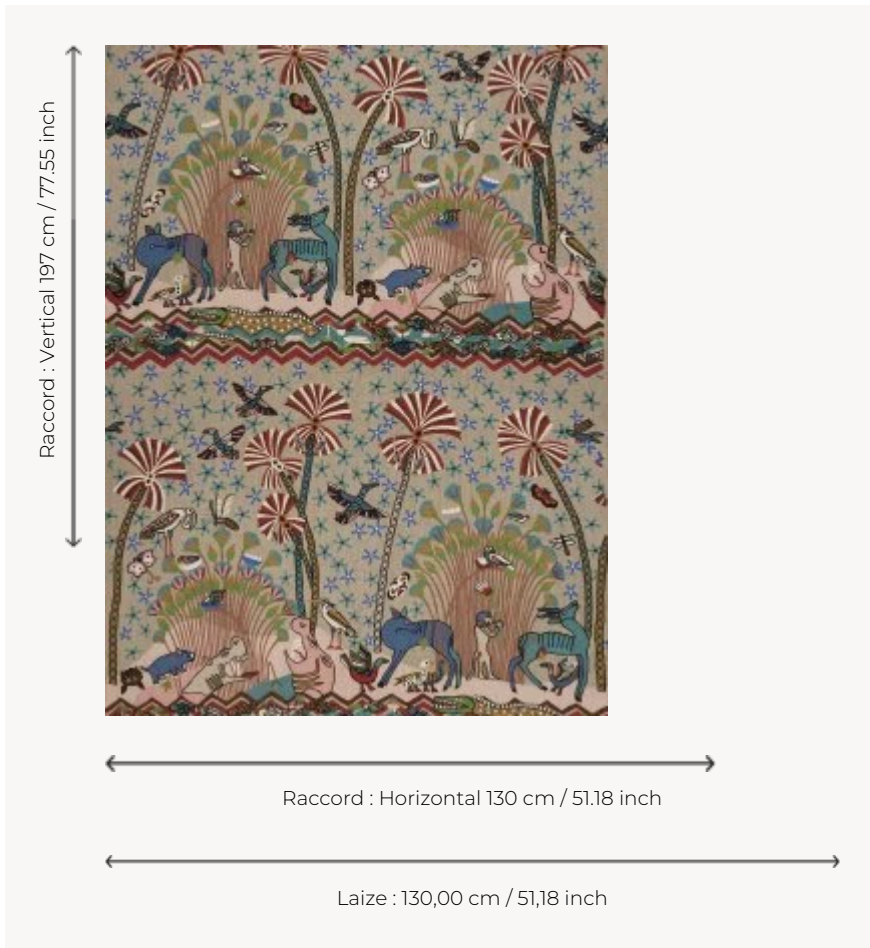


F3658001 FAUNE ET FLORE

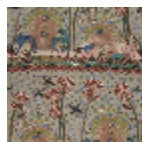

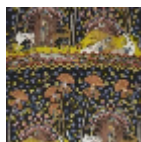
