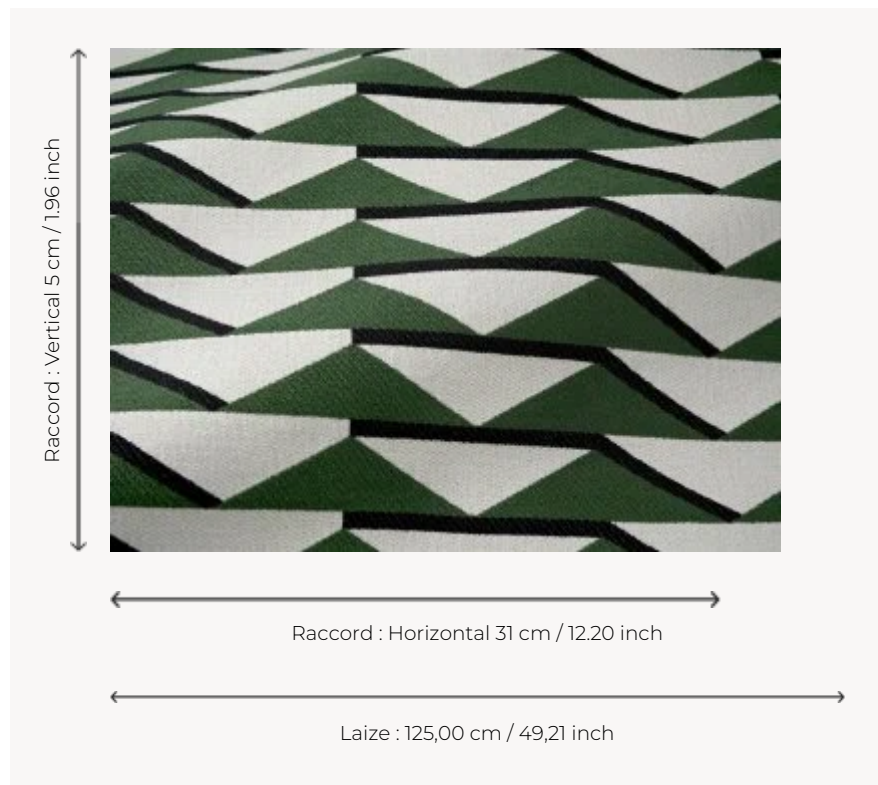


## F3709003 MEXIQUE

Timeless, this geometric jacquard is a reinterpretation of a modernist design by textile designer Elise Djo-Bourgeois imagined in 1930 and presented the same year on the Djo-Bourgeois stand at the Salon des artistes décorateurs in Paris. The flat areas of color are marked with a fine curly weft, reinforcing by its texture the relief induced by this graphic composition. Woven in the Pierre Frey workshops in northern France.

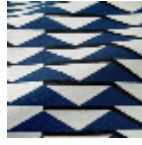
