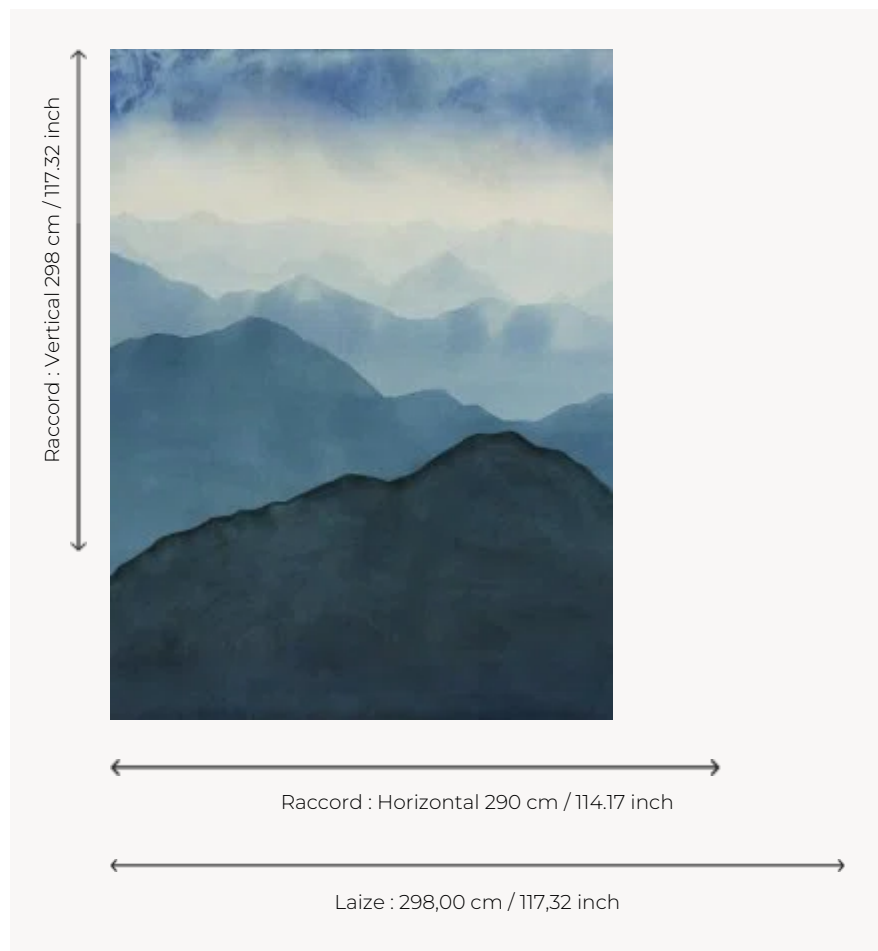


## F3726001 YUNNAN

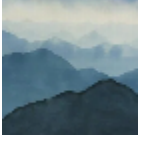
