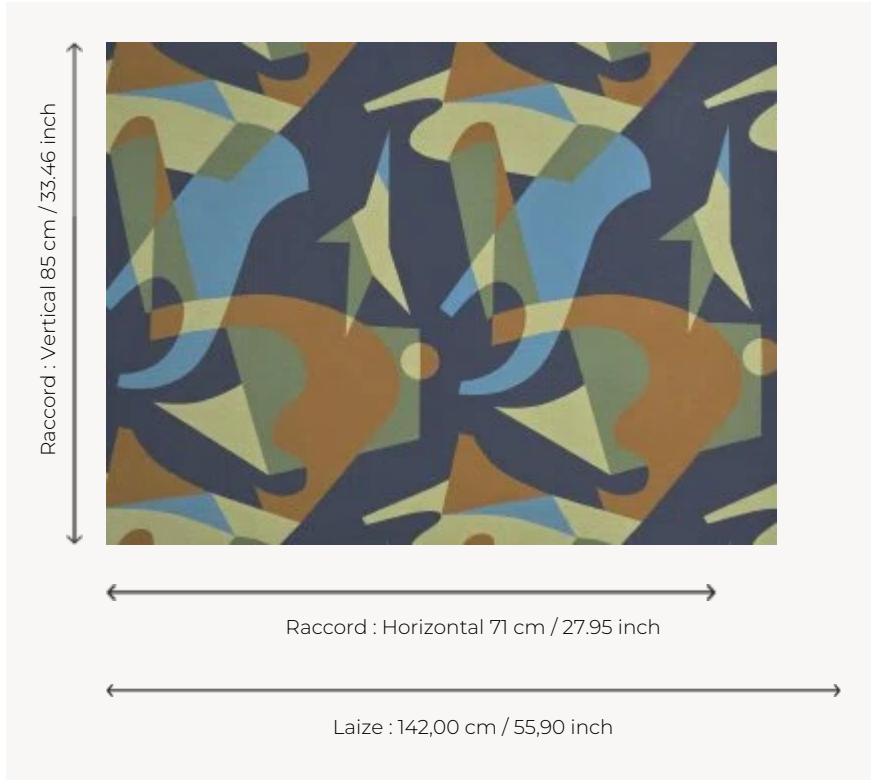



## F3751002 ARCHIPEL

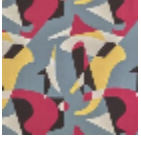
