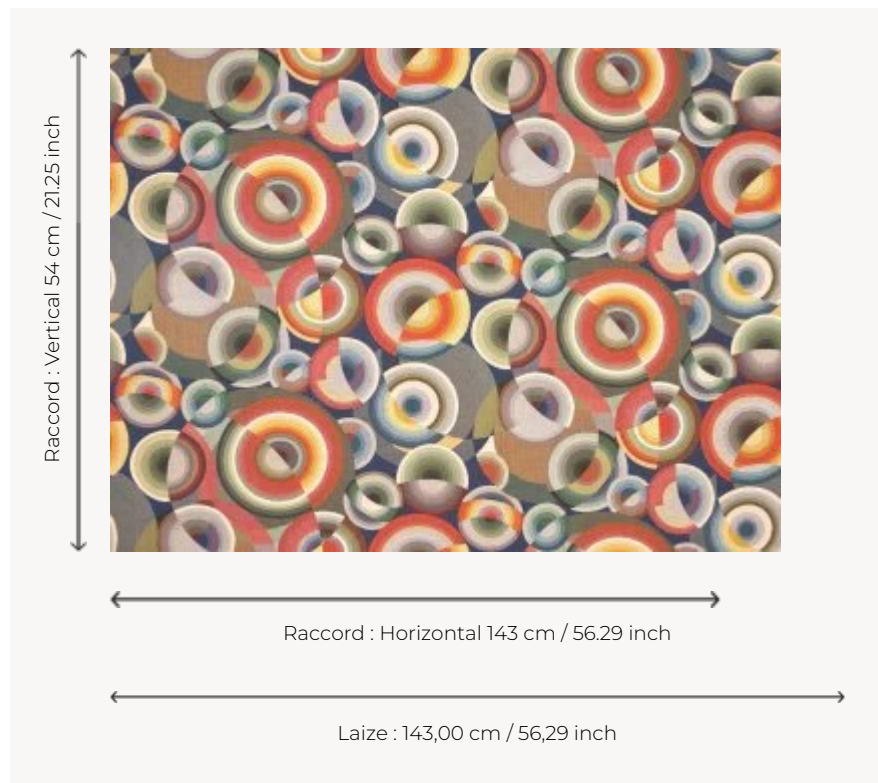



F3792001 MIL NEUF CENT VINGT TAPISSERIE

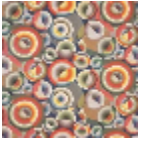
