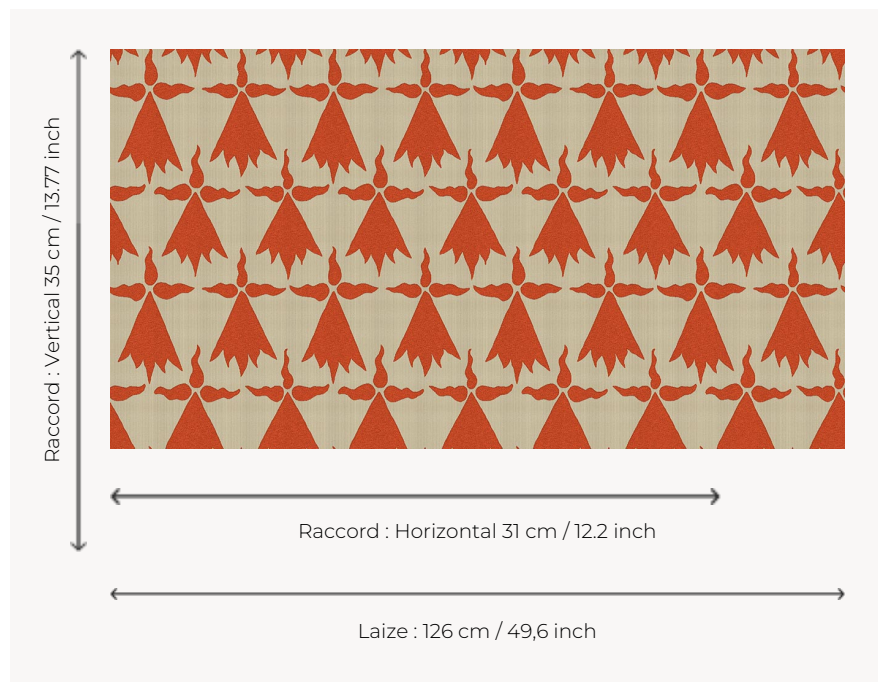


## L4157\_HERMINE\_N3005\_FG HERMINE
