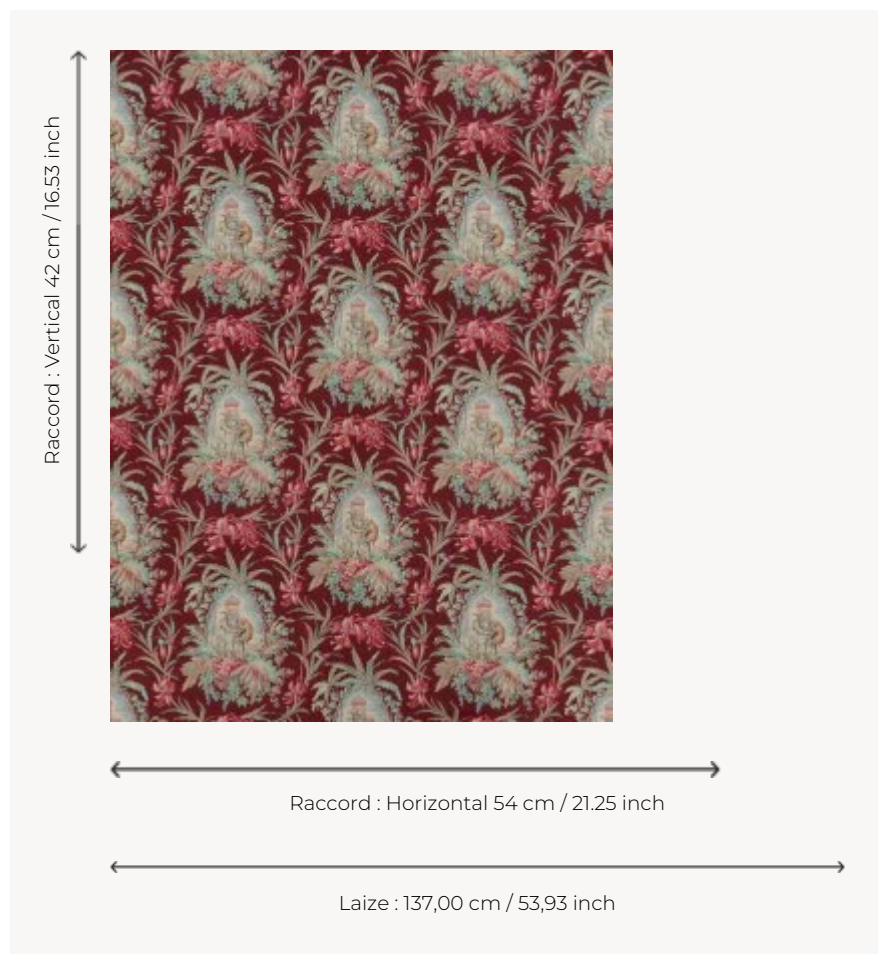


## L4174002 LES ELEPHANTS

Writers such as Lamartine in 1835 and Gérard de Nerval in 1851 contributed significantly to the development of this interest in the Orient. 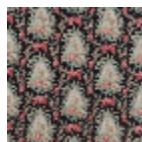

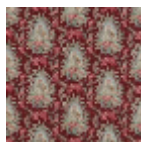
