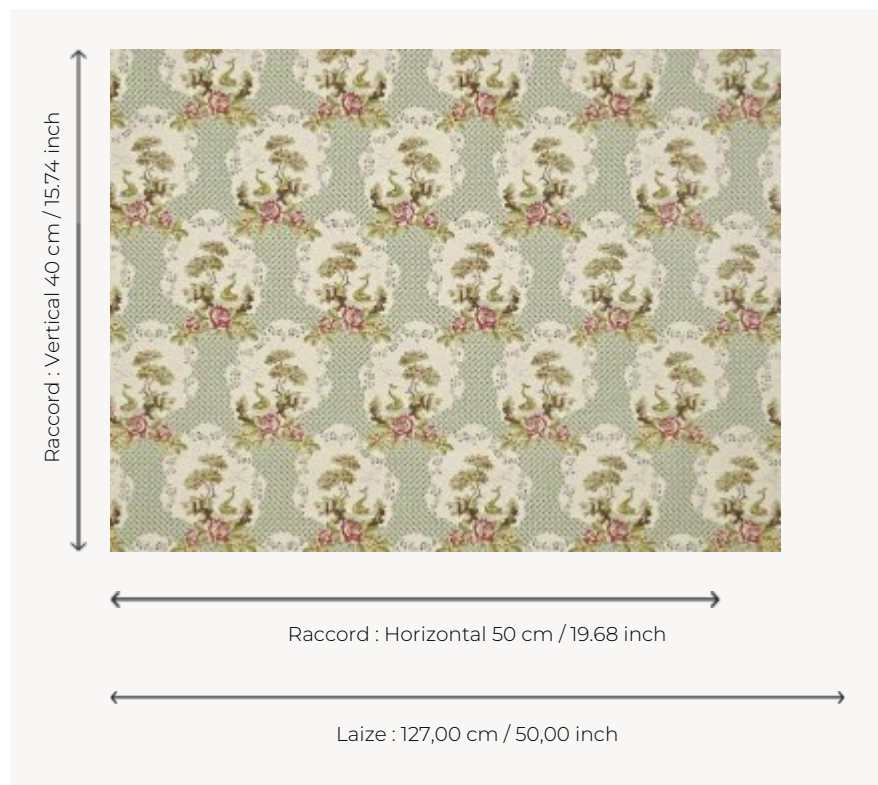


## L4562001 LE DAUPHIN

Both classic and original, this design, from Pierre Frey's archives, dated in the 1780s, is traditionally hand screen printed in France on cotton cloth. The theme may be an allusion to the 1781 birth of Louis XVI's first son, known as the dauphin.
