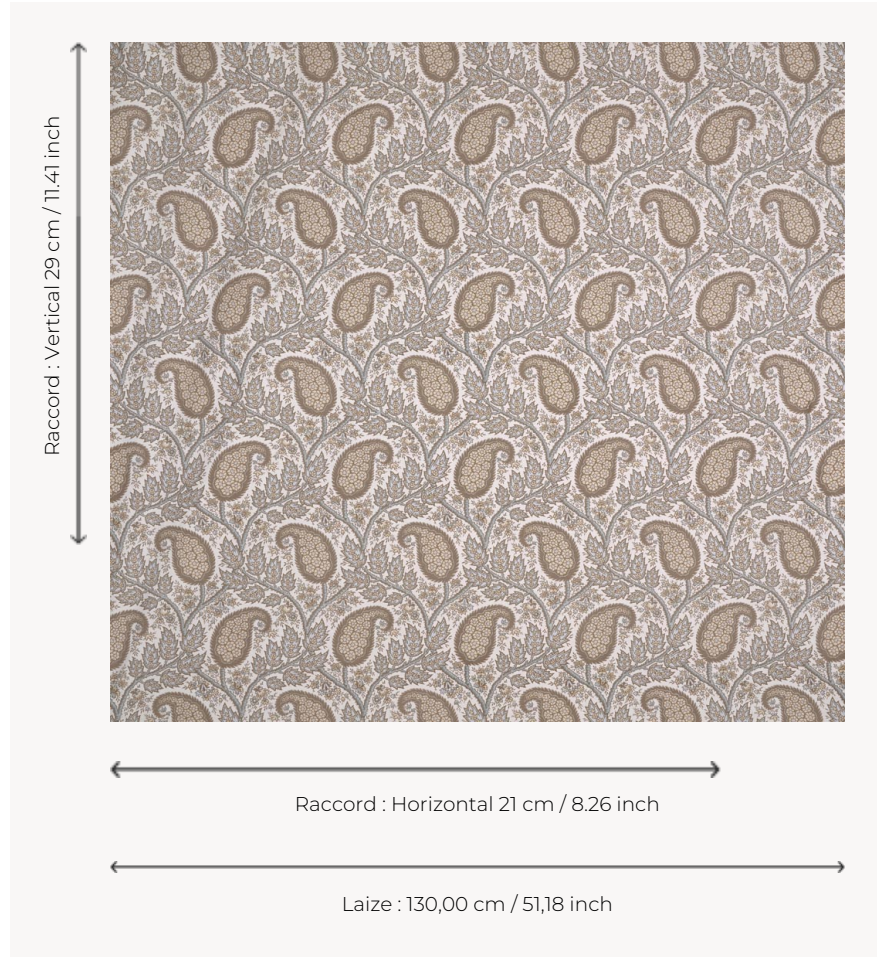


## T0108003 PHYSIC
