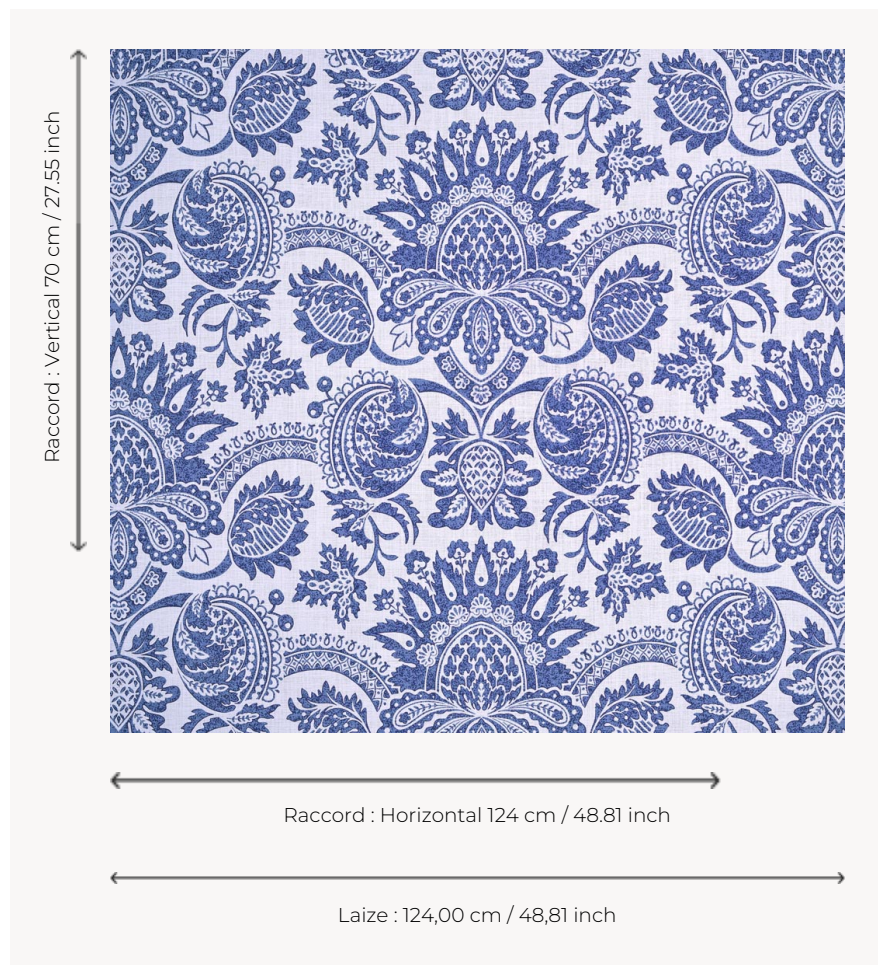


## T0296002 ST PETERS
