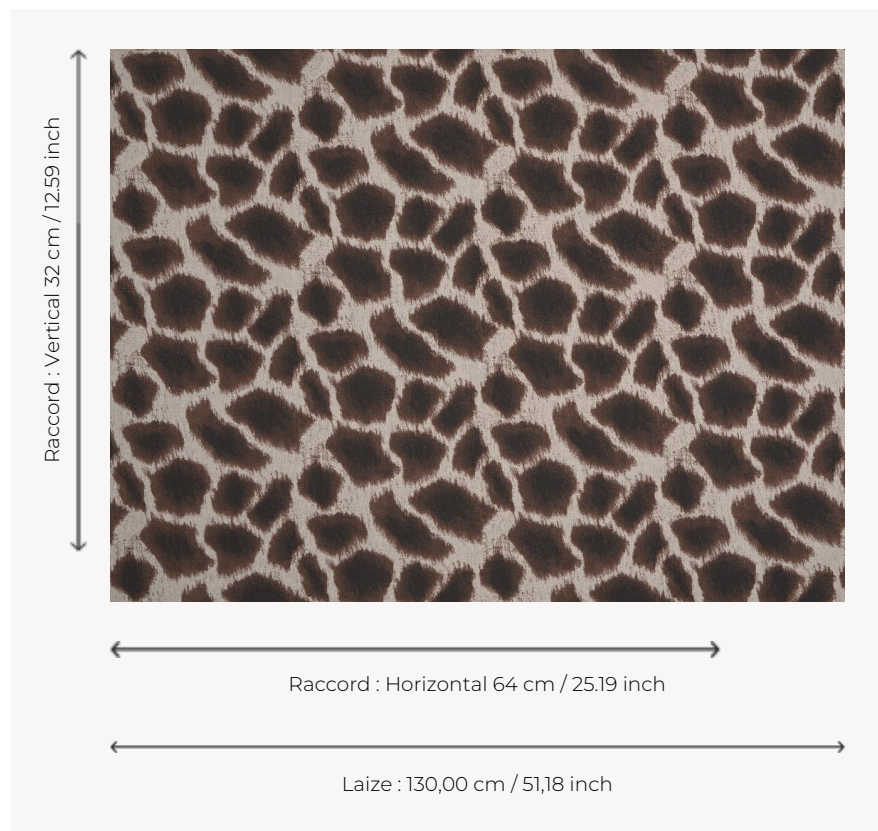


T0670003 GIRAFFE
