

FDORAPO DORA

The DORA line was inspired by the geometric aesthetics of cubism to create . The name DORA refers to Dora Maar, a French photographer and painter, who was one of the lovers and muses of the painter Pablo Picasso. This line is composed of a slipper chair, an armless sofa, a pouf and a table. It is part of an architectural composition in which semicircles, rectangles and squares are stacked to create a totemic construction. The tense and angular lines of the base become blurred and rounded to reveal a pleated back that brings softness and generosity to the whole.
