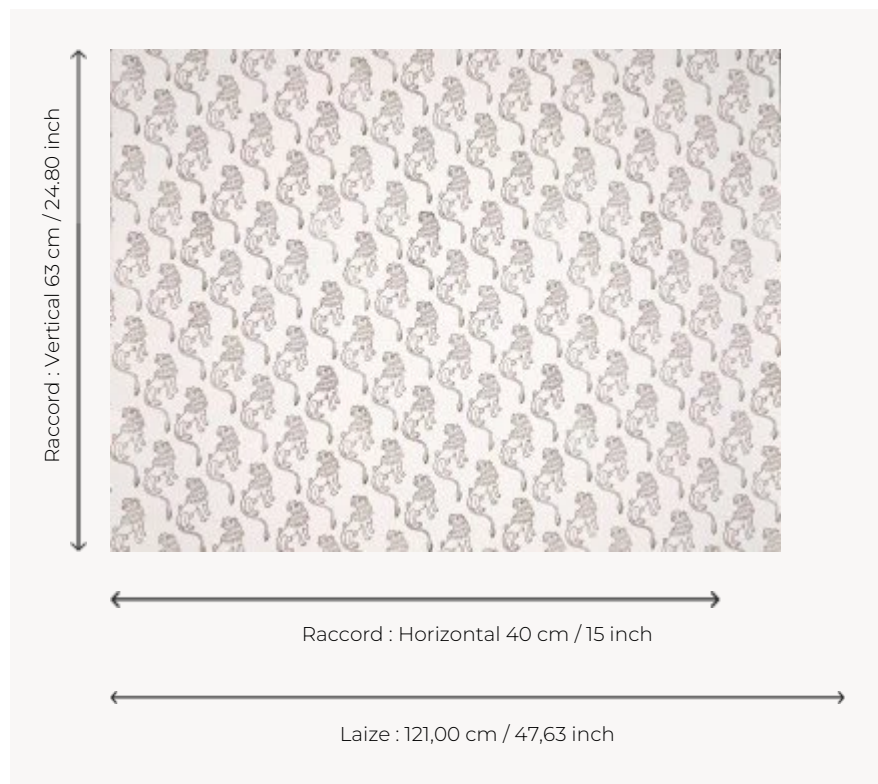



## BP368001 ZARAND COORDONNE

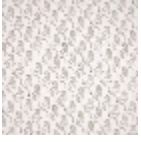
