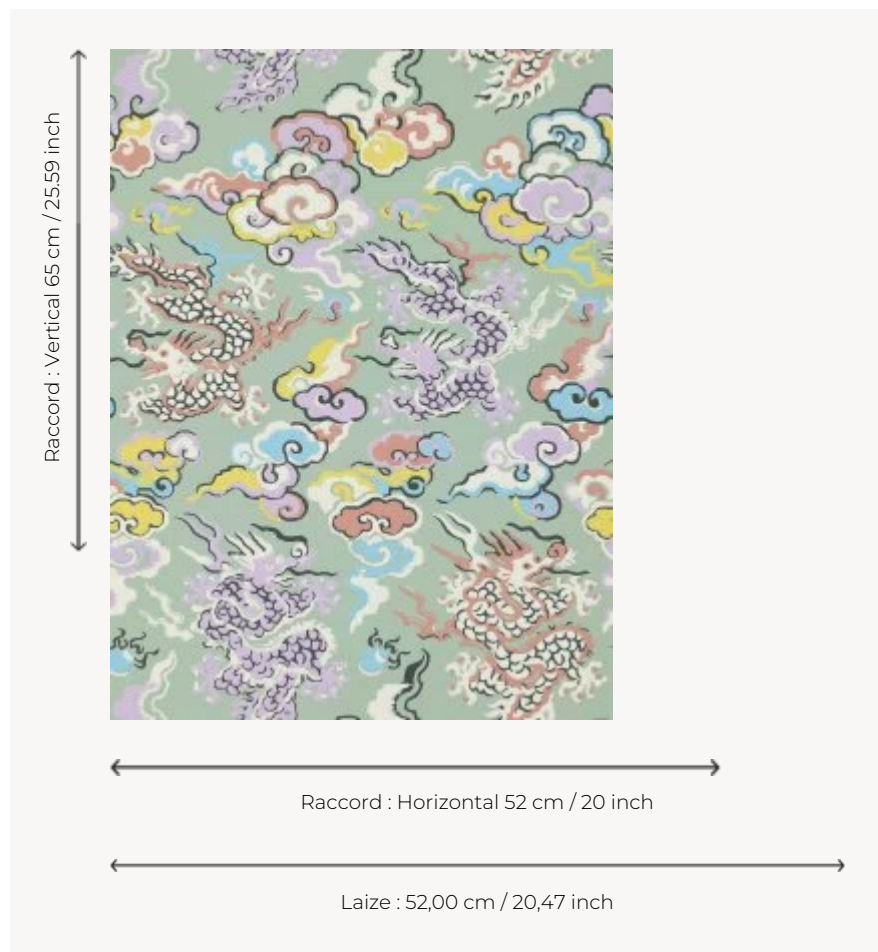



## FP763002 DRAGONS DE FEU

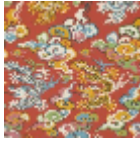

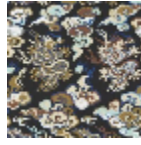
